CO_PILOT: OK. you've got two.

EMERGENCY MASTER WARNING: T6NL, T6NL

UNKNOWN: Inaudible

PILOT: Engine?

CO-PILOT: OK.

PILOT: Around the horn. Restart.

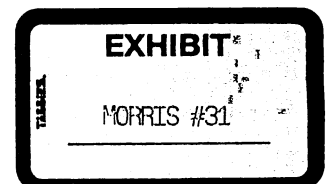
(Warning horn activated)
