

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE APPLICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ILLINOIS, INC. AND KENDALL LAND AND CATTLE, L.L.C. REQUESTING LOCAL SITING APPROVAL OF A NEW POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY IN LISBON TOWNSHIP, KENDALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS

NOTICE IS HEREWITH GIVEN THAT Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. and Kendall Land and Cattle, L.L.C. ("Applicants"), have filed an Application on June 3, 2008, with the County Board of Kendall County, Illinois, requesting siting approval for the Willow Run Recycling and Disposal Facility ("Willow Run") in accordance with Section 39.2 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and the Kendall County Site Approval Ordinance for Pollution Control Facilities, Ordinance No. 06-16 ("Siting Ordinance"). The Siting Ordinance is available at the office of the Kendall County Clerk, 111 W. Fox Street, Yorkville, Illinois 60560 or may also be found online at <http://www.co.kendall.il.us/landfill.htm>.

In their request, the Applicants seek approval to site, construct and operate Willow Run located at approximately one and one-half miles east of Illinois Route 47 and one-half mile east of the intersection of Ashley Road and Whitewillow Road, in unincorporated Kendall County.

The proposed development is a new municipal solid waste disposal facility located on an approximately 368-acre site, of which approximately 134 acres will comprise the waste disposal area, or "footprint". The vertical elevation of the facility will vary in topography ranging from 572 feet above mean sea level ("MSL") on the northeastern corner to 599 feet MSL on the northwestern corner of the site at its highest points.

Willow Run will receive general nonhazardous municipal solid waste, construction, demolition and such nonhazardous waste as are specifically permitted by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The facility will not accept liquid or

hazardous waste. The facility proposes to accept an average of approximately 3,571 tons per day of municipal solid waste and is projected to have an operating life of 14.5 years.

The Applicants are Waste Management of Illinois, Inc., whose address is 720 E. Butterfield Road, Lombard, Illinois 60148 and Kendall Land and Cattle, L.L.C., whose address is 23830 W. Main Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544. Kendall Land and Cattle, L.L.C. owns or holds options to the real property on which the facility is proposed to be built. The legal description of the site is as follows:

All interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing. Those who wish to participate and present sworn testimony or cross-examine witnesses must register as a participant with the County Clerk no later than the first day of the public hearing, or register with the Hearing Officer no later than the adjournment of the first day of the public hearing. Registration forms to become a participant are available at the County Clerk's office and are also available online at <http://www.co.kendall.il.us/landfill.htm>. All registered participants will be given an opportunity to be heard and participate in accordance with the terms of the Siting Ordinance. Please note that all copies of reports, studies, exhibits or evidence other than testimony to be submitted at the public hearing must be filed with the County Clerk by Tuesday, September 2, 2008 and in accordance with the terms of the Siting Ordinance.

Any person may file a written comment with the County Clerk concerning the appropriateness of the proposed facility for its intended purpose. The County Board will consider any such comment received or postmarked not later than thirty (30) days after the date of the last public hearing. Said written comments must be sent or delivered to the County Clerk, 111 W. Fox Street, Yorkville, Illinois 60560. Such comments shall become a part of the record of proceedings on the Application.
