VOTING ACCESSIBILITY

On March 17, 2020, a General Primary Election will be held for all polling places in Kendall County.

The following methods of casting a ballot are available to all Kendall County Voters:

Vote by Mail: February 6, 2020

Early Voting: February 6, 2020

Grace Period Voting: February 19, 2020

Election Day Voting: March 17, 2020

Any registered voter who is physically incapable of going to the polls on Election Day may apply to the County Clerk for a ballot to be voted at home. The vote may be cast by either the Vote by Mail or Disabled Voter Programs. An individual admitted to a hospital, nursing home or rehabilitation center, within 14 days of the election is eligible for the Hospitalized Voter Program. Pre-arranged Curbside Voting is also available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Handicapped and Elderly voters requiring help may be assisted by a friend, relative or by the Election Judges.
