HOOVER FOREST PRESERVE – SUGGESTED SUPPLY LIST

The bunkhouses at Hoover Forest Preserve have two sleeping wings with double bunk beds equipped with mattresses and sleep 32 people. The sleeping wings are separated by a kitchen, with stove and full-sized refrigerator, bathrooms with showers and a great room area with fireplace for table seating. A screened-in porch completes these buildings.

Two of our bunkhouses also offer 4 outdoor primitive cabins which sleeps 4 people in each, for an additional 16 people; and a total capacity of 48 people for these two bunkhouses.

Here is a list of some things you may wish to bring along.

Cooking utensils, plates, glassware, cups

Cookware such as pots and pans

Sleeping bags or blankets, sheets, pillows

Towels, facecloths, shampoo and soap

Matches, fire starters (you will need to purchase your firewood from us)

Dish cloth and dish towels, dish soap

Can and/or bottle openers
