



NOTIFICATION OF REDUCED SPEED LIMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION ZONE

Revision Date: June 19, 2018

On July 19, 2005, the Kendall County Board granted authority to the County Engineer to set reduced speed limits within construction or maintenance work zones (Ordinance No. 39) in accordance with 625 ILCS 5/11-605.2.

The referenced statute requires the local agency to maintain a record of certain information relating to each reduced speed zone. The Kendall County States Attorney has opined that the Kendall County Clerk should maintain this record. Therefore, I submit the following information for your record keeping. This notification will be updated periodically.
